SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the unnamed alley, located in the rear of 216 East Biddle Street, between Hunter Street and Guilford Avenue, is named ~~Mura Alley~~ the 200 Block of East Mura Street.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
