I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 08-0131.

**Zoning – Conditional Use Convalescent, Nursing, and Rest Home (Assisted Living) –
3615 Gwynn Oak Avenue**

For the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a convalescent, nursing and rest home (assisted living) on the property known as 3615 Gwynn Oak Avenue, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

The Department of Transportation has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0131. The proposed legislation would increase the capacity of the existing assisted living facility located at 3615 Gwynn Oak Avenue. After renovations to the second and third floors will accommodate 8 residents. There is off-street parking for four vehicles.

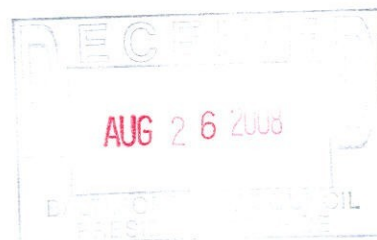
The Department of Transportation has no objection to the passage of this bill.
