The Baltimore Police Department (BPD) has reviewed City Council Bill 1111-0741-Volunteer Ambulance Service-Parking, Standing, and Stopping. The bill proposes to modify Article 31 § 6-26 to include volunteer ambulance services in the list of vehicles exempt from the enforcement provisions of this section.

The BPD does not have an objection to the proposal and requests that the Committee adopt the amendment language as suggested by the Department of Law. It is recognized that there are limited parking options for these types of vehicles and circumstances do warrant this modification for the benefit of our citizens.
