**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

1                   **City Property – Renaming Robert E. Lee Park to Lake Roland Park**

2       FOR the purpose of changing the name of the park known as Robert E. Lee Park, located at 1000  
3       Lakeside Drive, Baltimore, Maryland, 21210, to Lake Roland Park.

5       Article 5 - Finance, Property, and Procurement

7       Baltimore City Code

9           **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the  
10       name of the park known as Robert E. Lee Park, located at 1000 Lakeside Drive, Baltimore,  
11       Maryland, 21210, is changed to Lake Roland Park.

12           **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
13       after the date it is enacted.
