4	(Block 0108, Lot 030) and is no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special

11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in
12	accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the Comptroller of Baltimore City may
13	sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in
14	the property located at 1807 Harlem Avenue (Block 0108, Lot 030), containing 1.22 acres, more
15	or less, and improved by a 2-story building, containing 50,188 square feet, more or less, formerly
16	known as the Harriet Tubman Elementary School, and later as the Roots and Branches Charter
17	School, this property being no longer needed for public use.
18	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance
19	unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
20	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
21	enacted.
