City Streets – Opening – 1 **Dillon Street** 2 FOR the purpose of condemning and opening Dillon Street, extending from the east side of CSX 3 4 Transportation Inc. Railroad easterly 201.24 feet to the west side of South Macon Street, as 5 shown on Plat 307-A-21 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for 6 a special effective date. 7 By authority of 8 Article I - General Provisions 9 Section 4 and 10 Article II - General Powers 11 Sections 2, 34, and 35 12 Baltimore City Charter 13 14 (1996 Edition) 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Department of Transportation shall proceed to condemn and open Dillon Street, extending from 16 the east side of CSX Transportation Inc. Railroad easterly 201.24 feet to the west side of South 17 Macon Street, and more particularly described as follows: 18 19 Beginning for Parcel 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the east side of CSX Transportation Inc. Railroad and the south side of Dillon Street 70 feet wide 20 21 the point of beginning being distant Northerly 292 feet, more or less, measured along the east side of CSX Transportation Inc. Railroad from the north side of 22 O'Donnell Street varying in width; thence binding on the east side of CSX 23 Transportation Inc. Railroad Northerly 70 feet, more or less, to the north side of 24 25 Dillon Street; thence binding on the north side of Dillon Street Easterly 201.24 feet to intersect the west side of South Macon Street 60 feet wide; thence binding 26 27 on the west side of South Macon Street Southerly 70 feet to the south side of
