1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Baltimore City Landmark List – Senator Theatre**

3 FOR the purpose of designating the Senator Theatre, 5904 York Road, as a historical landmark.

5 Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation

9 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
10 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

12 **Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation**

13 **Subtitle 12. Landmark List - 2000s**

14 **§ 12-23. SENATOR THEATRE.**

15 SENATOR THEATRE, 5904 YORK ROAD.

16 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
17 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
18 Ordinance.

19 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
20 after the date it is enacted.
