<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – Zoning - Conditional Use Parking Lot - A Portion of 2700 Madison Avenue Known as 3002 East Drive

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking lot on a portion of the property known as 2700 Madison Avenue, the portion being known as 3002 East Drive, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.
