11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
12	Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

16	§ 57-3. Utility structures, etc.
17	(a) Prohibited conduct.
18	[If any] No person [shall] MAY wilfully break, defile, remove, deface, [or] carry away, OR
19	OTHERWISE DAMAGE OR INJURE any street lighting or other public utility structure, OR
20	ANY equipment, [or any] part, or appurtenance [thereof, installed at any place in the City,
21	or otherwise damage or injure the same,] OF A PUBLIC UTILITY STRUCTURE.

8 9 10 11	(1) Any person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to a fine of not more than $\$1,000$ or to imprisonment for not more than 12 months or to both fine and imprisonment for each offense.
12 13	(2) Each structure damaged or injured under this section is a separate offense.
14 15 16	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
