<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – Midtown Community Benefits District and Management Authority - Renewal Through June 30, 2024

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of renewing and continuing the Midtown Community Benefits District and Management Authority; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the activities and authority of the Midtown Community Benefits District and Management Authority.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – This bill looks to authorize operation of Midtown Community Benefits District for an additional 4 years. Midtown Community Benefits District has been in existence since the mid-1990's, serving the communities of Bolton Hill, Charles North, Madison Park and Mount Vernon. Property owners within the Midtown Community Benefits District catchment area pay an additional 13.2 cents per \$100 of assessed property value in the form of a surtax. The surtax is in addition to the City of Baltimore's standard property tax rate and supports supplemental services within the boundaries of Midtown Community Benefits District. The Department of Transportation foresees no significant fiscal or operational impact from the passage of Council Bill 20-0484.
