AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

Zoning – Conditional Use Pawnshop –
533/535 533 Oldtown Mall

FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of pawnshop on the property known as 533/535 533 Oldtown Mall, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a pawnshop on the property known as 533/535 533 Oldtown Mall, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 6-409(1) and 14-102, subject to the condition that the pawnshop complies with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements. The consolidation of 533/535 Oldtown Mall (Block 1288, Lot 78/79) and 537 Oldtown Mall (Block 1288, Lot 77) as 533 Oldtown Mall does not constitute a change in conditional use. The conditional use authorized by this Ordinance, namely a pawnshop, is limited to a maximum floor area of 3,000 square feet within the property now known as 533 Oldtown Mall.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of
