The usage of the ubiquitous plastic carry out/shopping bags has become extremely popular, however, ECB is in agreement that plastic bags are proliferating at an ever increasing rate and are detrimental to the environment.

In researching its affect on the environment, it is noted that plastic bags take more than 1,000 years to break down. Many accumulate in the ocean, causing severe problems for marine birds and mammals, such as choking and entanglement.
