BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 13 Sheet 76 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the M-3 Zoning District to 14 the R-8 Zoning District the property properties known as 1901 South Charles Street and 1900, 15 1904, 1910, 1916, 1924, 1926, 1928, 1930, 1932, 1934, 1936, 1938, 1940, 1942, 1944, and 1946 16 Light Street, as outlined in red on the amended plat accompanying this Ordinance. 17
 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;
