14 15 16	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Fiscal 2007 Fund Balance in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2008.
17 18	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2008 was formulated.
19	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
20	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2008 was formulated or is for a new program that could
21	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
22	On April 16, 2008, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
23	Council.
24	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
25	\$2,400,000 shall be made available to the Department of Transportation (Account #9965-580-
26	566) as a Supplementary Parking Enterprise Fund Capital Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2008, to
27	provide funding for the acquisition and installation of multi-space parking meters. The source of

- revenue for this appropriation is from the Fiscal 2007 Fund Balance in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2008.
