1. Information on the sign backlog broken down by type of sign, materials needed to clear the backlog, materials already procured, and additional materials needed for future work.
2. The process for retrieving handicapped parking signs issued for residents who are no longer there.
3. The number of requests for repaving alleys and sidewalks received, and the number of requests currently pending.
4. The number of pending footway requests, broken down by year received.
5. Data on traffic calming requests for the last three years, including whether each was accepted or declined and what considerations led to the decision.
6. The cost for DOT to analyze and report data on traffic calming requests City-wide, if additional analysis is required to provide the information requested above.
7. Existing spreadsheets used by DOT to track traffic calming requests.
8. DOT's plan for prioritizing additional state funding for transportation.
