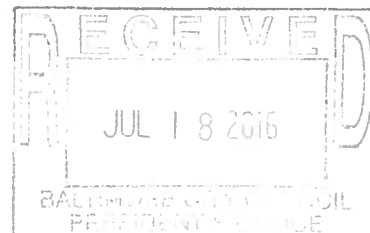
The BMZA, has reviewed the legislation and has no objection to the passage of Bill Number 16-0656.
