Dear President and City Council Members:

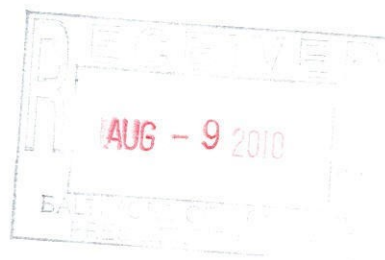
The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 10-0590 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would provide a registration fee for rooming houses, which used to be subject to a license fee. That license fee was deleted as part of City Council Bill 10-0516 but inadvertently not reinstated as a registration fee like those of other non-occupied properties.

Since the bill is consistent with Section 1of Article II of the City Charter, the Law Department approves it for form and legal sufficiency.
