1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Youth Football – Presence of Emergency Medical Services**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a youth sports program to have emergency medical services  
4 personnel present at all youth football games in which youth athletes participate.

10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

12 **Baltimore City Code**

13 **Article 7. Natural Resources**

14 **Subtitle 54. Youth Athletic Protection**

15 **§ 54-7. EMS PRESENCE.**

16 A YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM MUST HAVE AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN OR  
17 PARAMEDIC FROM THE BALTIMORE CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT’S EMERGENCY MEDICAL  
18 SERVICES DIVISION PRESENT AT ALL FOOTBALL GAMES IN WHICH YOUTH ATHLETES  
19 PARTICIPATE.

20 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
21 after the date it is enacted.
