Re: City Council Bill 08-0081 – Bond Issue – National Aquarium in Baltimore
Loan - \$500,000

The Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0081, which was introduced for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to create a debt and to issue and sell its certificates of indebtedness as evidence thereof, and proceeds not exceeding \$500,000 from the sale of such bonds to be used in connection with the operations, functions, and activities of the National Aquarium in Baltimore.

These funds will enable the National Aquarium to upgrade Piers #3 and 4, which includes the renovation of its life and electrical systems. This project will improve power usage and improve exhibit quality. These renovations will be a further asset to one of the Inner Harbor's core attractions. The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the adoption of City Council Bill 08-0081.
