2 **City Property – Renaming Mullan Park to Tupac Amaru Shakur Park**

3 FOR the purpose of changing the name of Mullan Park, located at 4000 Old York Road,  
4 Baltimore, MD 21218, to Tupac Amaru Shakur Park.

10 **Recitals**

11 Tupac Amaru Shakur, a proud son of Baltimore, who became one of one of the best-selling  
12 and most influential artists of all time. Tupac is an alumnus of both Roland Park Middle School  
13 and the Baltimore School of the Arts, and his family remember their times in Baltimore with  
14 much fondness and appreciation. As such, the Mayor and City Council find that naming the  
15 playground for Tupac, which sits behind the home he and his family once lived, to be a fitting  
16 honor.

17 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
18 name of Mullan Park, located at 4000 Old York Road, Baltimore, MD 21218, is changed to  
19 Tupac Amaru Shakur Park.

20 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
21 after the date it is enacted.
