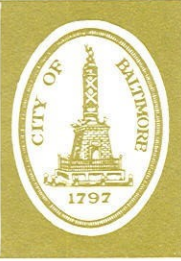

The Department of Planning has received City Council Bill No. 09-0345 for review. This bill is for the purpose of merging the Public Safety Conservation Area Advisory Board and the Baltimore Urban Lighting Board (BULB) into a new, reconstituted board; reviving the Public Safety Conservation Area Program; correcting, clarifying, and conforming related provisions; and generally relating to promoting a crime-free environment in neighborhoods.

The Department of Planning does not object to the reconstitution of this Board, as well as the improvements in public safety that will result. This bill supports the City's Comprehensive Master Plan, in the LIVE Section, Goal 1: Build Human and Social Capital by Strengthening Neighborhoods, Objective 3: Maintain and Create Safe, Clean, & Healthy Neighborhoods.
