

At its regular meeting of August 5, 2010 the Planning Commission considered City Council Bill #10-0572, which is for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain parcel of land known as the former bed of Diamond Street, extending from Fayette Street northerly 220.2 feet, more or less, to Shad Alley and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

In its consideration of this Bill, the Planning Commission reviewed the attached agenda, summary, and previous staff report, which recommended approval of City Council Bill #10-0572, and adopted the following resolution, nine members being present (nine in favor).
