Re: **City Council Bill 15-0474 - Waterfront Management District and  
Waterfront Management Authority – Renewal Through April 23, 2019**

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 15-0474, for the purpose of renewing and continuing the Waterfront Management District and Waterfront Management Authority; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the activities and authority of the Waterfront Management District and Waterfront Management Authority.

If enacted, this bill would renew the Waterfront Management District and Authority for another four years, through April 23, 2019. The Waterfront Management District and Authority (District) was created in 2007 to provide maintenance and beautification services to enhance the visitor experience around Baltimore's Inner Harbor. The initial four year term of the District was extended in 2011 until April, 2015.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 15-0474.
