City Council Bill #08-0097 would require certain materials used in connection with the sale of certain residential property to disclose the estimated amount of property taxes and assessments a buyer would be obligated to pay. It also would require the Finance Department to assist a seller in estimating the full-year property tax required to be disclosed.

The Finance Department has no objection to the passage of this bill, although it should be noted that the Bureau of Revenue Collection might require additional resources to respond to requests from home sellers for help in determining the correct property tax amounts to advertise. With 1,000 to 2,000 home sales per month in the City, the volume of such requests could be significant.
