10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

12 **Baltimore City Code**

13 **Article 19. Police Ordinances**

14 **Subtitle 46. Signs – Campaign Signs in Residential Areas**

15 **[§ 46-3. Maximum size.**

16 (a) *In general.*

17 No sign erected under this subtitle may exceed an area of 16 square feet.

18 (b) *Computing area.*

19 A sign's area shall be computed as provided in § 11-203 of the City Zoning Code.]

20 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
21 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
22 Ordinance.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

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1       **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
2 after the date it is enacted.
