11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
12	Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

15	\$ 6.507 Trans fats prohibited
16	§ 6-507. Trans fats prohibited.
17	(a) "Food containing trans fat" defined.
18	(1) "Food containing trans fat" means, except as provided in paragraph (2) of this
19	subsection, any food that:
20	(i) is labeled as containing vegetable shortening, margarine, or any kind of
21	partially hydrogenated vegetable oil;
22	(ii) lists vegetable shortening, margarine, or any kind of partially hydrogenated
23	vegetable oil as an ingredient; or
24	(iii) contains vegetable shortening, margarine, or any kind of partially
25	hydrogenated vegetable oil.

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1 2 3	(2) "Food containing trans fat" does not include food with a nutrition facts label or other documentation from the manufacturer that lists the food's trans fat content as less than 0.5 grams per serving.
4	(B) Exceptions.
5	This section does not apply to:
6 7	(1) FOOD THAT IS SERVED DIRECTLY TO PATRONS IN THE ORIGINAL SEALED PACKAGE OF THE MANUFACTURER; OR
8	(2) BAKERY PRODUCTS OF AN ESTABLISHMENT THAT:
9 10	(I) PREPARES THE PRODUCTS AND SELLS THEM EXCLUSIVELY AT RETAIL ON THE SAME PREMISES; OR
11 12	(ii) prepares the products and sells them at no more than 3 retail locations operated by the establishment within the City.
13	(c) [(b)] Prohibited use, etc.
14 15 16	[(1)] Except as provided in [paragraph (2) of this subsection] SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, food containing trans fat may not be stored, distributed, held for service, used in preparation of any menu item, or served in any food service facility.
17 18	[(2) This subsection does not apply to food that is served directly to patrons in the original sealed package of the manufacturer.]
19	(D) [(c)] Labels; documentation.
20 21 22	(1) (i) Except as provided in SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION OR IN subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, a food service facility must maintain on site the original label for any food:
23	(A) that contains fats, oils, or shortenings;
24 25	(B) that is required by federal or state law to have a label when purchased by a food service facility; and
26 27	(C) that is stored, distributed, held for service, used in preparation of any menu items, or served by the food service facility.
28 29 30 31	(ii) The Health Commissioner may permit a food service facility to submit acceptable documentation from the manufacturer that indicates whether a food contains vegetable shortening, margarine, or any kind of partially hydrogenated vegetable oil, or that indicates a food's trans fat content.
32	(3) If a food contains fats, oils, or shortenings and is not required to be labeled when
33 34	purchased, the food service facility must obtain and maintain documentation from the

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1	margarine, or any kind of partially hydrogenated vegetable oil, or that indicates the
2	food's trans fat content.
3	(4) The Commissioner may adopt rules or regulations that govern the documentation
4	acceptable or required under paragraphs (i)(ii) and (2) of this subsection.
5	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
6	are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
7	Ordinance.
8	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect
9	simultaneously with the taking effect of Ordinance 08-001 {"Food Service Facilities – Trans
10	Fats"}, which enacted City Code Health Article § 6-507 {"Trans fats prohibited"}.
