**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

1                   **Repeal – Reisterstown Plaza Transit Station Urban Renewal Area and Plan**

2                   FOR the purpose of repealing Ordinance 09-219, which established the Reisterstown Plaza  
3                   Transit Station Urban Renewal Area and Plan; and providing for a special effective date.

4                   BY repealing

6                   **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That  
7                   Ordinance 09-219 is repealed, and the authority conferred in that Ordinance to establish the  
8                   Reisterstown Plaza Transit Station Urban Renewal Area and Plan is rescinded.

9                   **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is  
10                  enacted.
