SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the

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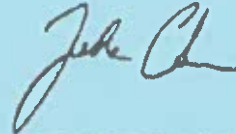
1 § 10-1. Homestead property.

2 Pursuant to the authorization contained in State Tax-Property Article § 9-105, for the taxable
3 year beginning July 1, [1993,] 2026, 2027, the homestead credit percentage for the City
4 property tax is [104%.] ~~106%~~ 105%.

5 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
6 after the date it is enacted.
