Re: City Council Bill 23-0346 – RPP Area 48 (Riverside) – Revisions

Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department reviewed City Council Bill 23-0346 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill modifies the hours of applicable parking restrictions for Residential Parking Plan Area 48 (Riverside), reducing the non-permit parking time threshold, establishing an exception to the applicable permit limit, and correcting and conforming related provisions. The bill is effective 30 days after the date it is enacted.

Baltimore City Code Article 31, § 10-19(a) provides:

At any time after a Parking Management Plan has been adopted by administrative regulation, the Mayor and City Council may enact an Ordinance rescinding or modifying the administrative regulation and the Parking Management Plan created by it.

The Parking Management Plan for Area 48 (Riverside) was adopted by administrative regulation and is in effect in Area 48. The City Council has the authority to modify the administrative regulation and the Parking Management Plan for Area 48-Riverside.

The Law Department approves this bill for form and legal sufficiency.
