

Baltimore City Green Collar Jobs Creation Coalition

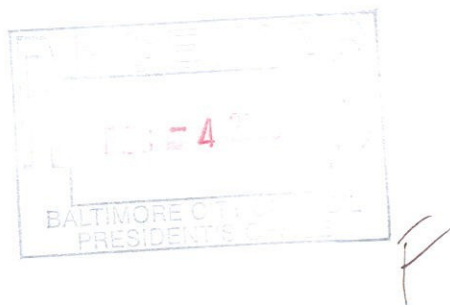
