


The Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation staff is in receipt of City Council Bill #21-0056:

FOR the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for the Canton Industrial Area to revise 5 the boundary of the Plan to remove a certain property; replacing certain exhibits to reflect the 6 change; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this 7 Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with 8 certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

This item has been scheduled for a committee hearing before the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation will be able to review it and provide a recommendation to the committee. The staff to CHAP has reviewed the bill and has determined that the bill will have no impact on the historic properties within the area and defers to the Planning Commission.
