The Commission, having reviewed the bill and having read the staff report, approved the following motion (7 members present; 7 members in support):

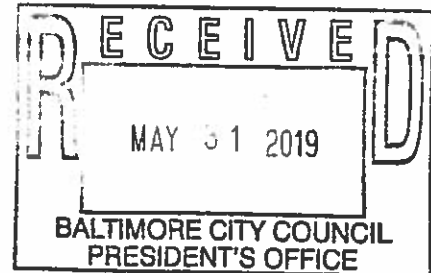
A finding of no objection to the amendment and deferral to Planning regarding land use and zoning.
