A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation –**
3 **Department of Health – \$1,000,000**

4 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the
5 amount of \$1,000,000 to the Department of Health – Program 310 (School Health), to
6 provide funding for additional operating expenses; and providing for a special effective date.

12 **Recitals**

13 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Hotel Tax (\$103,000)
14 and the Vacant Property Registration Fee (\$897,000) in excess of the revenue relied on by the
15 Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year
16 2011.

17 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
18 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.

19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
20 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated or is for a new program that could
21 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

22 On June 21, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
23 Council.

24 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
25 \$1,000,000 shall be made available to the Department of Health – Program 310 (School Health)
26 as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011, to provide
27 funding for additional operating expenses. The source of revenue for this appropriation is from
28 the Hotel Tax (\$103,000) and the Vacant Property Registration Fee (\$897,000) in excess of the

1 amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy
2 required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
