3 FOR the purpose of extending the period within which applications may be accepted for the tax  
4 credit for historic restorations and rehabilitations; and providing for a special effective date.

10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

13 **Article 28. Taxes**

14 **Subtitle 10. Credits**

15 **§ 10-8. Historic restorations and rehabilitations.**

16 (m) *Termination of program.*

17 Applications for the credit may not be accepted after February 28, [2009] 2014.

18 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
19 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
20 Ordinance.

21 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect February 28,  
22 2009.
