Re: **City Council Bill 17-0145 - City Streets – Opening – 8-Foot Alley Extending from the East Side of North Schroeder Street**

---

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 17-0145, for the purpose of condemning and opening an 8-foot alley, extending easterly 76.5 feet, more or less, from the east side of North Schroeder Street to the east side of a 4-foot alley, as shown on Plat 329-A-24 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

If enacted, this bill, a companion bill to 17-0146 (Closing 8-foot Alley...), would allow the closing of an alleyway that is no longer needed to support development in the Harlem Park neighborhood.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 17-0145.

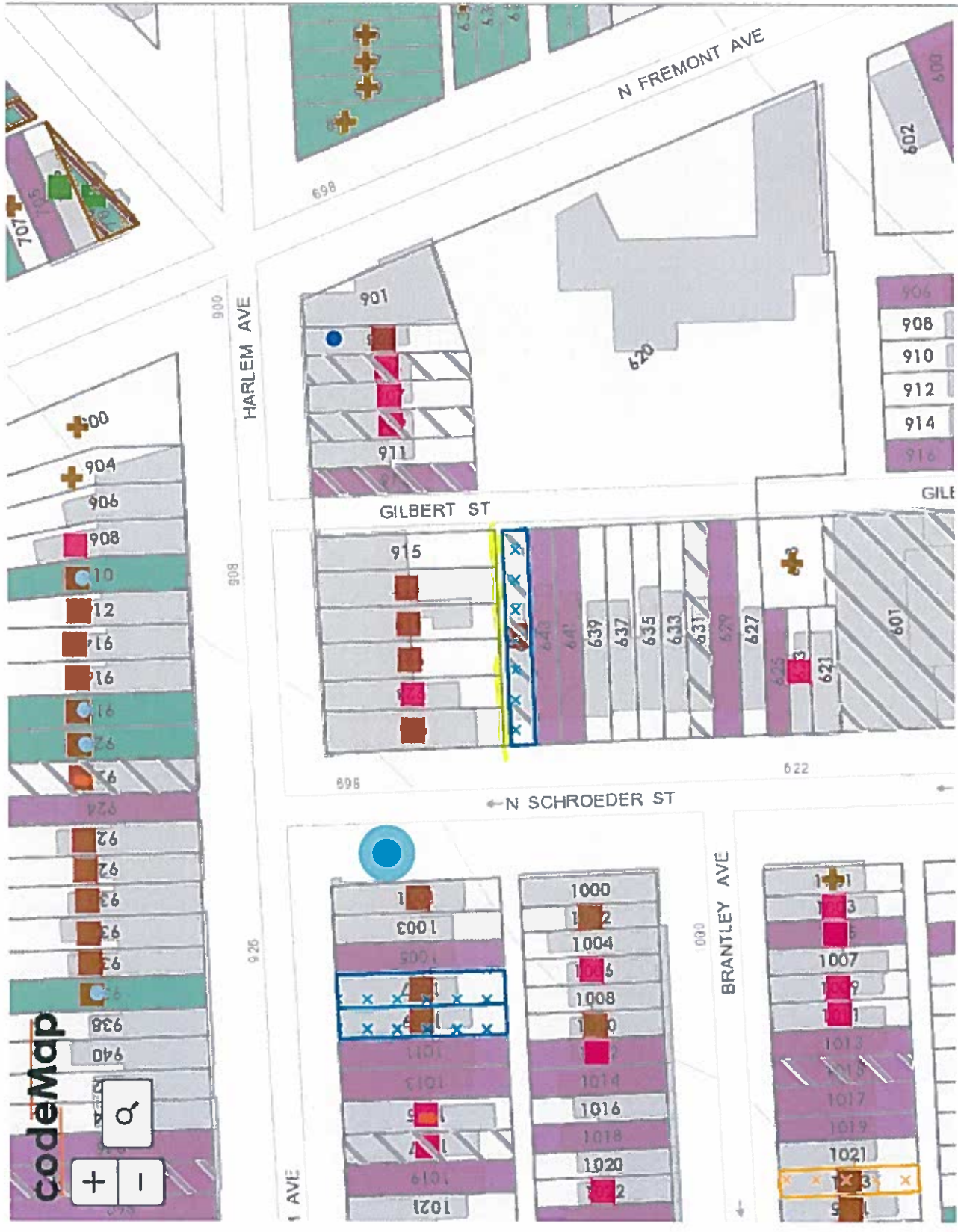
