I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 08-0135.


**Planned Unit Development – Amendment 4 – York Road and Belvedere Avenue (Belvedere Square)**

**For the purpose of approving certain amendments to the Development Plan of the York Road and Belvedere Avenue (Belvedere Square) Planned Unit Development.**

The Department of Transportation has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0135 and concurs with the amendments proposed by the Department of Public Works. Additionally, we ask that the bill be amended in Section B and G, to include a “pedestrian safety plan”. We also ask that the traffic, pedestrian safety and parking plans be reviewed and approved by the Department of Transportation, The Parking Authority and the Right of Way section of the Department of Public Works. We would further amend the bill to make it clear that the public sidewalk along Belvedere Avenue will be unobstructed. With these issues addressed, we have no objection to the bill.

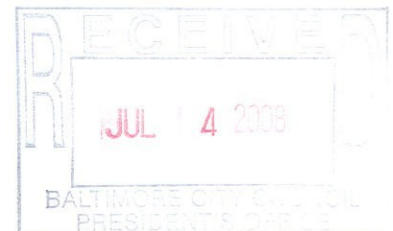
We will continue to work with Councilman Henry’s Belvedere Square Ad Hoc Committee to improve traffic safety in the area.
