<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – City Streets - Opening - North Durham Street

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of condemning and opening North Durham Street, extending from East Eager Street Northerly 433 feet, more or less, to the south side of East Chase Street, as shown on Plat 341-A-45 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.
