The Baltimore City Environmental Control Board (ECB) is pleased to have the opportunity to review Council Bill #14-0445, Prohibited Open Flame Cooking—Enforcement by Citation. The purpose of the bill is to authorize the issuance of environmental and civil citations to enforce the existing prohibition on the use of an open-flame cooking device within 10 feet of a combustible construction or property line.

The ECB anticipates that the number of citations that will be issued for a violation of the relevant provision will have no significant impact on ECB operations. For this reason ECB has no objections to the passage of this bill.
