Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Extension of the Complaint Filing Period: The main issue was the proposal to extend the current complaint period for unlawful practices from 180 days to 300 days. This change would align the Baltimore City law with the Maryland State Commission on Civil Rights and the federal counterpart.
- 2. Process and Timeline Explanation: Ty'lor Schnella from the Mayor's Office explained that the bill seeks to adjust the timeline for the CRC's investigation of complaints. The bill's primary goal is to give individuals more time to file complaints, thereby making them more viable.
