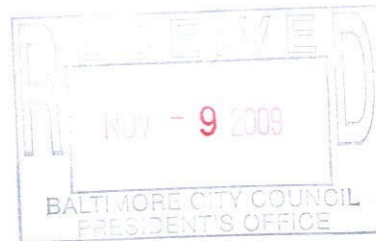
I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 09 - 0410 introduced by Council President Stephanie Rawlings-Blake at the request of the Department of Housing and Community Development.

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the Urban Renewal Plan for Carroll Camden to revise an exhibit to reflect the disposition changes in the Plan; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

The Urban Renewal Plan for Carroll Camden was originally approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by Ordinance 02 - 296 and last amended by Ordinance 09-195.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. has reviewed Council Bill 09 - 0410 and determined there would be no impact to any administered parking program for on-street parking activity and / or City owned off-street parking facilities.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 09 - 0410.
