


I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 10-0436.

**BMore Streets for People Program – Establishment**

DOT supports the spirit of City Council Bill No. 10-0436, which would provide for the administration of the proposed BMore Streets for People Program. The Program would consist of a series of events accompanying the special and periodic closing of City arteries to vehicular traffic for the purpose of welcoming jogging, biking, and skateboarding. Specifically, this bill would establish a BMore Streets for People Advisory Board.

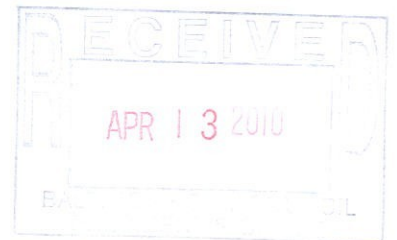
