FOR the purpose of designating St. John’s in the Village, 3009½ Greenmount Avenue, as a
historical landmark: public interior.

BY adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation
Section(s) 13A-3
Baltimore City Code
(Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

Subtitle 13A. Landmark List: Public Interiors - 2010s

§ 13A-3. ST. JOHN’S IN THE VILLAGE.

ST. JOHN’S IN THE VILLAGE, 3009½ GREENMOUNT AVENUE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
after the date it is enacted.
