
I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 08-0206.

**Planned Unit Development – Designation – Sinai Hospital-Levindale**

**For the purpose of repealing the existing Development Plan for the Sinai Hospital Planned Unit Development and approving a new Development Plan for the Sinai Hospital-Levindale Planned Unit Development.**

The Department of Transportation has reviewed the new development plan for the Sinai Hospital-Levindale Planned Unit Development (CC 08-0206). DOT has been working with the developers to mitigate traffic issues related to the project. We are hopeful that this worthy development can move forward. At this time, however, we respectfully ask the Committee to hold the bill until such time as a signed traffic mitigation agreement is executed. We would also point out to the Committee that the Department of Planning’s bill response concurs with our position.
