9 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the

14 **§ 10-8. Historic improvements, restorations, and rehabilitations.**

15 (m) *Termination of program.*


16 Applications for a credit under this section may not be accepted after [August 28, 2024]
17 DECEMBER 31, 2027.

18 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
19 enacted.
