14	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Simulated Slots
15	(\$573,000), Miscellaneous Citation and Penalty Amounts (\$17,000), and the Annual Nonprofit
16 17	Contribution (\$817,000) in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
18	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
19	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.
20	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
21	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated or is for a new program that could
22	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
23	On June 21, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
24	Council.
25	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
26	\$1,407,000 shall be made available to the Department of Housing and Community Development
27	as a Supplementary Capital Fund Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011, to provide funding for the
28	demolition and stabilization of blighted properties. The source of revenue for this appropriation
29	is from the Simulated Slots (\$573,000), Miscellaneous Citation and Penalty Amounts (\$17,000),

- and the Annual Nonprofit Contribution (\$817,000) in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
