15	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
16	permission is granted for the conversion of a single-family dwelling unit to 2 dwelling units in
17	the R-8 Zoning District on the property known as 2132 West Baltimore Street (Block 0190, Lot
18	015), as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with the
19	Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 5-201(a) and 9-701(2), subject to the condition that the building
20	complies with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.
21	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That pursuant to the authority granted by §§ 5-
22	201(a), 5-305(a), and 5-308 of Article 32 - Zoning, permission is granted for a variance from the
23	requirements of § 9-401 (Table 9-401: Rowhouse and Multi-Family Residential Districts - Bulk
24	and Yard Regulations) and § 9-703(d) for the lack of the required lot size.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.
