**INTRODUCTION** – This bill proposes the closing of a portion of Eastbourne Avenue and a 10' alley, at the request of the adjacent property owner.

**PURPOSE/PLANS** – The intent of this bill is to allow for the developer, Two Farms (The parent organization of Royal Farms), to consolidate lots and renovate an existing Royal Farms Store.

**BRIEF HISTORY** – The street and alley to be closed are currently being used by the existing business, this closing will formally and legally allow for this use. The opening and closing of streets and alleys are covered under Article 26, Section 3 of the Baltimore City Code.
