11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the
12 unnamed alley, located in the rear of 216 East Biddle Street, between Hunter Street and Guilford
13 Avenue, is named Mura Alley.

14 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
15 after the date it is enacted.
