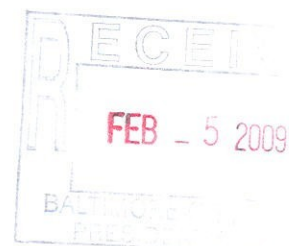
The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0235, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and closing Diamond Street, extending from Fayette Street northerly 220.2 feet, more or less, to Shad Alley, as shown on Plat 347-A-63A in the Office of the Department of Public Works.

City Council Bill 08-0235 and its companion bills, 08-234 and 08-236, would open, close and then authorize the sale of a portion of the former bed of Diamond Street from Shad Alley to Fayette Street. This would allow the University of Maryland, Baltimore to secure the entranceway and control the access to a new 16-story high-rise residential building being constructed for graduate student housing.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 08-0235.
