AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

**Revenue Obligations — Wastewater Projects —
Maximum Aggregate Principal Amount**

FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum aggregate principal amount of revenue obligations that may be issued by the City under Ordinance 07-421; and providing for a special effective date.

Recitals

Ordinance 02-332 authorizes the City to issue from time to time its revenue obligations to finance wastewater facilities within the geographical limits of the City's wastewater system. The maximum aggregate principal amount of revenue obligations authorized to be issued under Ordinance 02-332, as last amended by Ordinance 07-421, is \$880,000,000.

Certain recent events have occurred that affect the aggregate principal amount of revenue obligations that may be required to finance wastewater facilities, including (without limitation) an increase in the number of wastewater facilities

1 that the City may desire to finance with the proceeds of the sale of revenue
2 obligations.

3 Accordingly, the City desires to increase to \$1,110,000,000 the aggregate
4 principal amount of the revenue obligations that may be issued under that
5 Ordinance.

6 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
7 Section 2(a) of Ordinance 02-332, as last amended by Ordinance 07-421, is amended and
8 restated to read as follows:

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That:

10 (a) Revenue obligations may be issued from time to time in an aggregate
11 principal amount not to exceed [\$880,000,000] \$1,110,000,000 for the
12 general public purposes of financing or refinancing the cost of the
13 financed facilities and repaying the City for amounts expended on
14 financed facilities in anticipation of the issuance of the revenue
15 obligations.

16 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That Ordinance 02-332, as last amended by
17 Ordinance 07-421 and this Ordinance, continues in full force and effect.

18 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it
19 is enacted.
